Job Description

- q Assist Wrangler in guiding guests - children, teens and adults on trail rides into mountain trails
- q Gather, feed, groom and saddle horses daily
- q Maintain and clean tack
- q Maintain facilities, corrals, tack shed, trails and grounds
- q Cut new trails and/or maintain existing trails
- q Help maintain and repair pastures and fences as needed
- q Care for sick and injured animals under supervision
- q Perform misc. ranch chores

Job Requirements

- q Some horseback riding and horsemanship preferred but not required
- q Must have a desire to learn more about horses and horsemanship
- q Must be able to lift 75 pounds
- q Must wear proper attire - including cowboy hat (provided), boots, jeans, and western shirt or Palaka (provided)
- q Must follow Gunstock Ranch safety policies and procedures
- q Must have a strong work ethic
- q Must have good attendance
- q Exhibit a genuine concern for guest safety while riding and around horses
